As per guidance from NHS England we will be carrying out flu/ covid vaccinations at Northlands Surgery after the 3rd October 2024. This may be later than you've had the vaccines before, but it means you'll have the best protection when flu is most widespread. We will be in touch nearer the time. 2-3 year olds and pregnant ladies can be vaccinated from September.
